

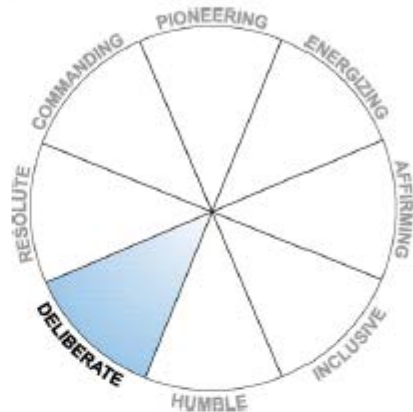


The 8 Dimensions of Leadership

Deliberate leaders want to create a sense of stability, to solve problems, and, more than anything, to ensure accurate outcomes. They like to have a plan, and they'd much rather over-prepare than risk failure. Personal competency matters to them, and they want to be seen as having expertise in their fields. Because they're analytical leaders who communicate in a straightforward manner, they may have little patience for people who seem illogical or more interested in schmoozing than getting work done. They tend to be reserved, and they often prefer working with close colleagues to socializing with large groups or attending professional networking events.
